



Anti-Social Behaviour - extra support for residents

In the last ezine, we let you know that we were working with the police and residents to further improve how we handle Anti-Social Behaviour (ASB).

We have already taken on board that learning and have launched a new ASB Respect Line. This means you now have experts on hand out of normal working hours to report any ASB incidents.

The ASB Respect Line team has highly trained call-handlers with backgrounds in housing or policing. With extensive experience in dealing with sensitive ASB-related calls, each team member undergoes individually tailored training covering witness support, government legislation, housing policy and procedure and ASB tools and powers.

As well as being on hand when our office is closed, the ASB Respect Line team will also make calls to check in on those who have previously reported ASB and have given permission to be contacted for a welfare check.

It's free to call the ASB Respect Line, you can reach the team on **0800 075 6699**. The line is open 5pm until 9am on Monday to Friday, and all weekends, and bank holidays. They'll then let us know of any calls, so we can work with you to resolve these.

During normal working hours you should continue to contact our **Customer First**

Health and safety award for Templer HomeBuild

The team, who complete repairs for residents, have claimed the Gold Award demonstrating its dedication to ensuring its staff and residents are safe during every working day.

The RoSPA Health and Safety Awards is the largest occupational health and safety awards programme in the UK. Now into its 67th year, the Awards have almost 2,000 entries every year, covering nearly 50 countries and a reach of over seven million

employees. The programme recognises organisations' commitment to continuous improvement in the prevention of accidents and ill health at work.



Free local energy saving advice on hand

Residents of Alberta Court and Bitton Court, in Teignmouth, recently benefitted from a talk about saving money and energy.

Healthy Homes for Wellbeing is a free energy and money saving advice service for vulnerable people living in Exeter, Mid Devon, East Devon, Teignbridge, and Torbay.

Their team of trained Home Energy Advisers provide practical energy advice and support by telephone and face to face, with the aim of helping as many residents as possible to save money and stay warm in their homes.

Everyone can access advice, but you can also get a free home visit and potential free energy saving measures such as draught proofing and LED light bulbs if you have a household income of less than £31,000 and receive tax credits or housing, income or disability related benefits.

Investing in homes

Each year Teign Housing invests around £9 million in improving and maintaining homes.

To ensure we spend that money on the things that matter most to residents, we seek your views through our resident involvement panels and groups, and also visit homes to know we have an accurate picture of what work is needed so it can be scheduled in.

Soon, Rand Associates, will be visiting 720 properties in the Dawlish and Teignmouth areas to complete stock condition surveys on our behalf. By 2024 we plan to have visited around 50% of all homes we own.

By completing this work, we will know which areas and properties are most in need of new kitchens, bathrooms, roofs and more. So if your home is selected, please do make and keep the appointment.

Our team and contractors working on our behalf will always carry identification. Do check people are genuine before letting them in.



New homes in Okehampton

In March we officially received six new homes, as part of a wider development scheme in Okehampton.

Persimmon, the developer, handed over the first six of 20 properties, which are available for affordable rent and shared ownership. They are a mix of one to four bedrooms and are part of a wider 50 home development called Fatherford View.
